## Master of Business Administration (MBA) in Global Business

The MBA-program can be completed in 13.5 months accompanying the participants' job. It is not only characterized by the short period of time it takes to attain the degree but also by its internationality and its contents. All courses are taught in English.

The MBA-program is addressed to all interested individuals holding an initial academic degree from a recognized or accredited university or college with work experience to impart an international General-Management-Education with broad-based, practical and business knowledge. This MBA-program is open for all interested parties, regardless of their companies' belonging to the Würth-Group.

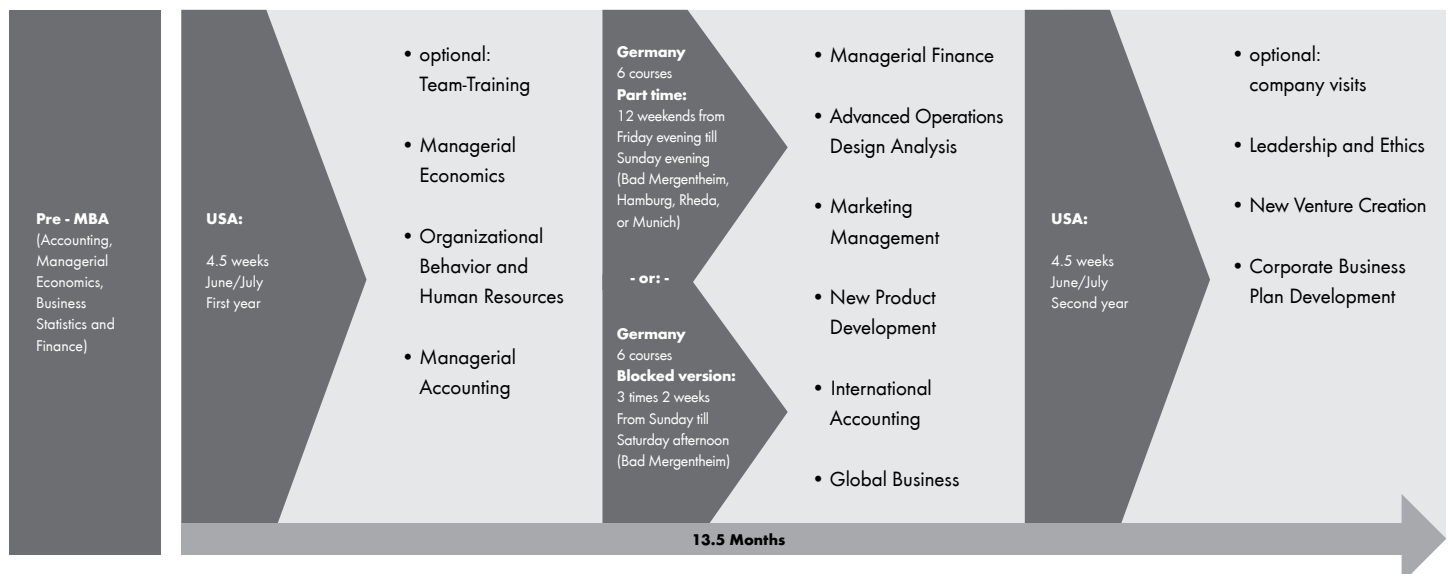
The MBA-degree will be awarded by the AACSB-accredited College of Business, the University of Louisville. Since 2007, this program has been accredited by the European institution FIBAA as well. Accreditations serve as mark of quality which is an important precondition for the official recognition of MBA-studies.

The entire study-program consists of 12 courses with 3 US-Credits each. Half of the courses take place in the US during two periods of attendance of 4.5 weeks each. Prior to the period of your first stay at the University of Louisville (UofL), you have the chance to participate in an optional 3 days Team-Training in Traverse City (Michigan, USA). Before your second stay in the USA, the UofL offers the opportunity to visit US companies such as General Electric, FORD, UPS, Toyota or Tricon.

The contents of the 6 courses which are taught in Germany will be lectured between the 2 periods of attendance in the US depending on the study model you choose:

The 6 part-time courses (each lasts 2 weekends) take place from Friday 5.30 pm till Sunday 5 pm in Bad Mergentheim, Hamburg, Munich or Rheda/Wiedenbrück. The blocked version (each lasts from Sunday 2 pm till Saturday 1pm) is only offered by the Akademie Würth in Bad Mergentheim.

## Application and costs

### Prerequisites for Admission:

All application credentials must be submitted in English.

- Statement of motivation
- Curriculum vitae
- Diploma from a recognized or accredited university or college degree with a „B“ or better cumulative grade point average (German: “2.7” or better). Exceptions with regard to the grade of the university degree are possible in case of the prospect’s special qualification.
- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language): at least 213 points (computer based) or 80 points (web based); alternative: 30 minutes conversation in English with the academic director of the program
- 2 letters of reference
- Personal interview with the academic director
- At least 3 years of work experience
- Successful completion of the Pre-MBA-course (preparation course is offered online)

### Registration deadline:

1st of March 2012, 2013, 2014

### Start of study:

June 2012, 2013, 2014

### Costs:

(Effective 2010-04-01, subjects to modifications.)

The tuition fee is EUR 17,950. Books are included. All other costs such as flight tickets, VISA-fees or accommodation in the USA must be covered by the participant. Application fee: EUR 950 (incl. Pre-MBA-course)
